Citizens Bank of West Virginia has pledged \$25,000 to Davis Medical Center for the complete transformation of its Emergency Department. Once completed, the renovation and expansion will include 20 private exam and treatment rooms, plus 2 state-of-the-art trauma bays, 2 isolation rooms, updated medical equipment, and a new waiting area.

Phase 2 of construction has begun and completion is expected by this August.
